## MICROPLASTICS

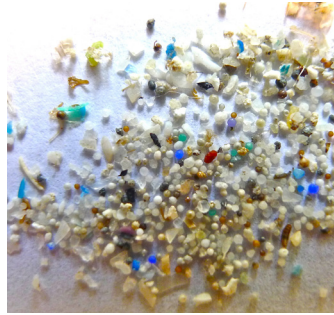
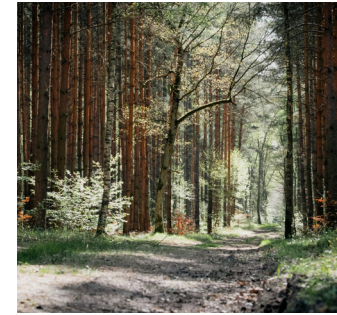

## ENVIRONMENT



The surroundings in which people, animals and plants live.

**Plastic pollution can harm the environment.**

## SINGLE-USE PLASTIC



Plastic items which are usually used once and then thrown away.

**Half of the plastic made each year is single-use plastic.**

## BIODEGRADABLE



Material or objects able to be broken down naturally without harming the environment.

**Fruit is biodegradable as it will rot over time.**

## NON-BIODEGRADABLE



Material or objects which cannot be broken down naturally. They pollute and damage the environment.

**Plastic is a non-biodegradable material.**
